


Is India Really 'Winning Its War' on Open Defecation

About 892 million people, or 12 percent of the global population, practiced open defecation in 2016. Seventy-six percent (678 million) of the 892 million people practicing open defecation in the world live in just seven countries. India is the country with the highest number of people practicing open defecation, around 569 million people.

Over 5 lakh defecate in the open due to lack of toilets in Delhi

MAJOR REASON BEHIND OPEN DEIFICATION

POOR NFRASTRUCTURE

POOR MAINTENENCE

- There are around 100 slum clusters in Delhi without toilet facilities, and women in these slums have to walk considerable distances to relieve themselves.
- lack of toilets is not the only reason behind this preference for open defecation. Improper maintenance of the existing ones and restrictive timings have forced residents to head out into the open.
- According to a Comptroller and Auditor General (CAG) report released in 2015, 30 percent of constructed toilets were found to be dysfunctional.
- out of 229 toilets 70% were not clean, 65% had no flush facility, 50% had no water supply, 70% had no signage's and almost 70% were not disabled friendly.
- Lack of water near toilet: Absence of supply of water inside or next to toilets cause people to get water from a distance before using the toilet. This is an additional task and needs extra time.

- Poverty or lack of access to toilets are not the only factors: research has shown that many Indian villagers believe public defecating is healthier, and continue the practice even after a toilet is built in their area.
- Presence of toilet but not privacy: Some toilets do not have a real door, but have a cloth hung as a door. In some communities, toilets are located in places where women are shy to access them due to the presence of men
- Social norms: Open defecation is a part of people's life and daily habit in INDIA. It is an ancient practice and is hard for many people to stop practicing. It is a part of a routine or social norm. In some cultures, there may be social taboos where a father-in-law may not use the same toilet as daughter-in-law in the same household.

The mission of **project** सुविधा is to eradicate open defecation and facilitate safe sanitation to urban slum dwellers in New Delhi.


- Ensuring that urban slum dwellers uses the toilet and put an end to open defecation,by generating awareness about safe sanitation




BEUTIFICATION OF TOILET COMPLEX


